## OUR SERVICES

Crossville Veterinary Hospital specializes in the care of cats, dogs, pet chickens, rabbits, reptiles and most pocket pets. We provide a wide range of services to fit your every need.

Dr. Denning recommends a preventative approach to healthcare. Beyond annual

exams, that includes dental care (which protects your pet's heart, kidneys and oral health), blood work (provides early signs of internal organ issues), heartworm prevention (protects against cardiopulmonary issues as well as zoonotic diseases), and flea & tick protection (protects skin from irritation as well as internal organs from parasites). We offer both traditional and anesthesia-free dental cleanings. The latter may be better for older pets or those with certain medical conditions.

Dr. Denning is a skilled surgeon. She has eighteen years of experience of providing elective and emergency surgery to her patients. Her expertise ranges from standard spays and neuters to eye and bladder surgery.

We have an experienced full-time groomer on-site who can meet all of your pet's bathing and trimming needs as well as a broader range of services.
